NOTICE TO ALL VALUED ONLINE APPLICANTS REGARDING CURRENT EVISA INTERNET PAYMENT GATEWAY TRANSITION

PNG Immigration and Citizenship Authority (ICA) is currently undertaking a transition from an overseas Internet Payment Gateway (IPG) to PNG IPG via ICA's authorized Banking and IPG Service Partners/ Providers with the current existing Border Management System (BMS) Provider/Partner.

The technical team have been working closely together over the last few days testing the proposed transition plan to minimize downtime and maintain business continuity but have identified technical complexities that will require extended days to address and therefore there will be 'EVISA ONLINE APPLICATION' outages experienced during and after 15th December 2022 until Tuesday 20th December 2022.

You may also have to visit the nearest overseas missions for further assistances in regards to Visa lodgement/etc.
